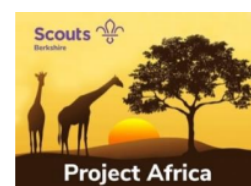

We had our annual visit to play Petanque.

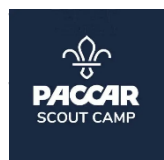
We had another fun filled sleepover at the RAF Museum near London for Pillows and Pilots!
